We still had to wear starched junpers, though!






Jap 75mm Guns on Mt Shiborangu.










In late 1972, a number of "ITS TIME" T shirts were imported from Australia.

Picture also shows the only surf beach near populated areas in PNG???





Bones found in the area and thought to be Japanese were placed here and later repatriated to Japan




Cape Wom memorial to Japanese Surrender - 1972




Cape Wom Beach.


Boat is Catholic Mission Barge used for moving people and equip around Wewak.


